- Address poverty and mental health issues that are impacting our urban and rural areas
- Strengthen parenthood, for both mothers and fathers, and the nuclear family

MAKE OUR ELECTIONS SECURE BY MAKING IT HARD TO CHEAT

The foundation of our self-governance is liberty, and the core expression of the people's liberty is the ability to cast their ballots in free and fair elections. Every eligible Nebraska voter should have the opportunity to cast one ballot at one time that is counted once. Anything that fails this simple test is a failure of the system, and people committing voter fraud must be held accountable.

- Require voters to have photo identification and eliminate ballot harvesting
- Adopt ballot security measures to ensure no counterfeit ballot is counted
- Ban dark money groups from giving money to election officials to influence elections
- Allow people at the county level to determine how their votes are counted
- Change how Nebraska allocates its presidential electors to a "winner take all" system

GROW OUR AGRICULTURAL INDUSTRY AND EXPAND ENERGY PRODUCTION

Agri-business is vital to Nebraska's economy and domestic ownership of our natural resources are a matter of national security. Ingenuity and entrepreneurialism have transformed our Ag products into a "best in class" world recognized commodity. Policies providing abundant and affordable energy for Nebraska's homes, communities and industries will enable our products to be competitive on the world stage.

- Strengthen the global demand for our agricultural products by reducing input costs
- Limit how many acres non-US foreign corporations may own and require annual reporting
- Provide for affordable energy and make Nebraska more energy independent
- Build a premier infrastructure system including roads, bridges, pipelines, and broadband

MODERNIZE NEBRASKA LEGISLATIVE RULES TO REFLECT "WE THE PEOPLE"

The Nebraska Unicameral has been plagued by outdated rules and procedures that do not reflect the values and needs of its citizens. As a result, a small group of senators can block legislation desired by an overwhelming majority of Nebraska families and communities. It is way overdue for legislators to change their procedural rules so beneficial legislation may become law.

- Require open and transparent senator votes when electing legislative committee chairs
- Reduce the cloture vote requirement so that 17 senators cannot block legislation
- Make the Unicameral a partisan body so voters know their senator's party allegiance
- Make available online video recordings of all floor debate and hearings within 24 hours
- Require all legislative fiscal notes are publicly available three days prior to a hearing
